Student Council Code of Conduct

The following document details the **expectations and responsibilities** of a Student Council member at South County High School. The guidelines provided below are considered minimum standards and students may be asked to take on additional responsibilities throughout the year.

Expectations

- All Student Council members must pledge to maintain the highest standards of personal conduct, to act in the best interests of their school at all times, to reflect opinions of the students they represent to the best of their ability, to promote school spirit and model the purpose of Student Council.
- Student Council and General Assembly meetings require strict attendance. Any council member missing more than two meetings will be removed and replaced by another student. Student Council meets every FOCUS Homeroom period along with a General Assembly held once per quarter.
- Being a member of Student Council will require your dedication, initiative, and time. It is expected that you will attend all meetings which will require you to manage your time effectively. Be advised that your homeroom time will be taken away due to having to attend Student Council Meetings. If your ability to meet this requirement is impacted by other activities or classes, you must be an active advocate for yourself and be able to balance between your multiple responsibilities.
